### Transfer of Copyright by Contributors to TMS Publications

The authors warrant and represent that they are all of the authors of the work identified above, and they are the sole owners of the work and of the copyright pertaining to it, that they have not transferred the ownership of the work or of the copyright in the work or any interest therein or any part thereof to any other person or entity. The work is the original creation of the authors and is not copied from any other work, except for the portions which are clearly indicated by credits contained therein.

The copyright of the article identified above is hereby transferred to The Masonry Society (for U.S. Government employees this provision applies only to the extent which copyright is transferable) effective upon receipt of the manuscript.

In consideration of TMS's agreement to publish the work if approved after review, within at least twenty-four months of this assignment, authors hereby assign exclusively to TMS the copyright pertaining to the work in this and all subsequent editions of the work (to include closures and errata), and in derivatives, translations, or ancillaries, in English and in foreign translations, in all formats and media of expression now known or later developed, including electronic.

If TMS does not publish the work within 24 months it hereby agrees to reassign the copyright back to the authors.
